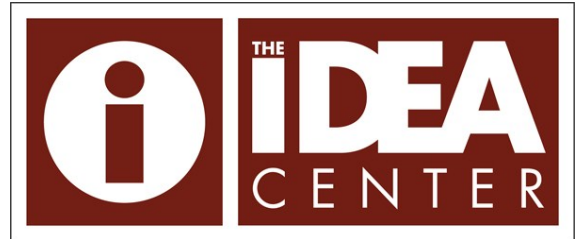

Accommodations

The Florida Hotel & Conference Center reflects the elegance of the grand hotels of the 1930s with its Art Deco style. Located at 1500 Sand Lake Road, seven miles from the airport, it adjoins the Florida Mall Shopping Center, which contains numerous shops and restaurants.
